**Directions to Duette Preserve** the far northeast corner of Manatee County  
We will meet at Ranger Station

It takes about 60 minutes to get here from “town” in Bradenton

**From Bradenton:** travel east on Manatee Avenue (SR 64) to Duette Road  
Duette Road is approximately 25 miles east of I-75.  
Look for this left turn, just past Wachula Rd., which will appear on your right.  
Turn left onto Duette Road and follow it to Rawls Road (6 miles from SR 64)  
Turn left onto Rawls Road, which is in an orange grove  
Proceed through grove to gate, enter and follow road to Ranger Station

**From Palmetto:** travel east on US 301 through Parrish  
At the blue “Tehano Night Club” turn east on SR 62 to Duette Road  
Duette Road is approximately 16 miles east of US 301  
Turn right onto Duette Road and follow to Rawls Road (past 1<sup>st</sup> Duette Gate)  
Turn left onto Rawls Road which is in an orange grove  
Proceed through grove to gate, enter and follow road to Ranger Station

**From I-75:** take Moccasin Wallow Road (Exit 229) east  
Continue east until it ends at US 301  
Turn right (south) on US 301 and travel about ½ mile to SR 62  
Turn left onto SR 62 (your landmark is the blue Tehano Night Club)  
Duette Road is approximately 16 miles east of US 301  
Turn right onto Duette Road and follow to Rawls Road (past 1<sup>st</sup> Duette Gate)  
Turn left onto Rawls Road, which is in an orange grove  
Proceed through grove to gate, enter and follow road to Ranger Station
